A subscription to UN Comtrade gives you instant access to 1.3 billion records on trade from over 200 reporting countries or areas, covering 45 years of data and more than 5000 different products. With UN Comtrade you spend your time researching instead of searching.

KEY FEATURES:

- **My Comtrade** Personalize your Comtrade pages, make your groups of countries or commodities, design your output file and save your own queries with My Comtrade.
- **Comtrade Explore** Enter country name, commodity or year and this data mining tool will give an instant overview of data you are looking for. Thereafter, you can dig for more refined data.
- **UN Comtrade Knowledge Base** This is a repository of background information on UN Comtrade. It explains how to use the functionalities, what the concepts are behind the data, why imports and exports differ and what the answers are to some frequently asked questions.
- **Community Forum** Users have instant online support via the UN Comtrade Knowledge Base. In addition, there is peer-to-peer support via UN Comtrade Community Forum, where you can post questions or give your own experience.

Access to World Integrated Trade Solution (WITS)

WITS is a simple to use yet powerful software which gives access to trade and tariff related statistical information; includes some simulation and analysis tools. Trade flows and tariff data can be extracted to be used in self-contained analysis and simulation tools or to be further computed outside WITS in spreadsheet or statistical software. In addition to Comtrade, WITS allows access to the following major trade flow & tariff databases: UNCTAD TRAINS and the WTO IDB and CTS.

DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE RATES (DSAR) ONLINE

DSA rates are intended to relate to good commercial hotels and restaurants at various locations for more than 250 cities around the world. An additional amount of 15 percent of the average hotel and meal cost is included in the DSA rate to account for incidental expenses. DSA rates generally relate to specific cities within the country.
